Dear parents and carers,

I am now in a position to confirm the current proposed arrangements for Wednesday 1st March.

We acknowledge that the decision for teaching staff to take strike action is not a decision they have taken lightly. The strike is happening because of a national dispute between the unions and the government and not because of any issues at our school.

Currently, we have planned for all children to be able to attend school as usual on this date. There may be a revised curriculum on the day if the number of staff striking increases. We will provide school lunches, wraparound care and afterschool clubs will also continue as usual. The parent reading session has been cancelled and will not take place on Wednesday 1st March.

I am sure you can appreciate this is an ever-changing situation and plans could change. I will update you with any changes to the plan as soon as possible.

Arrangements for the 15th and 16th March will be shared with you nearer the time.

I understand this situation may be frustrating but please can I ask that we continue to respect each other's opinions and support each other as a community.
