



<u>Small group work</u> Time with Teachers and Teaching Assistants for basic skills work.	<u>Dough Disco</u> A programme to support fine and gross motor skills encouraging children to strengthen their muscles in preparation for writing.	<u>Funtime</u> A highly structured programme that works on social and communication skills.	<u>Colourful Semantics</u> A teaching approach that aims to teach children how to build and understand sentence structures.
<u>Taming Tricky Words</u> A structured approach to support children's reading of tricky words by providing them with stories to help them remember each word.	Let's Talk Language Group An 8-week programme full of games and activities to increase children's vocabulary and speaking and listening skills.	<u>Friendship Skills</u> A 6-week programme of work that explores what it means to be a good friend, how to solve conflicts with friends and good games to play with friends.	<u>Drawing and Talking</u> A 6-week programme that supports children in identifying and dealing with how they are feeling.
<u>ELSA</u> Emotional Literacy Support Assistants. We have 2 trained assistants who work with children to develop their emotional literacy.	<u>Sunbeams Nurture Group</u> A group that provides children with highly focussed and individual targets to further develop their academic, social and emotional potential.	<u>Comets</u> A small group provision with high adult to child ratio. Focussing on sensory needs, interaction and communication.	<u>Talk Time</u> A group that runs once a week to provide children with the opportunity to be listened to and to reflect on the week's events at school or home.
<u>Big Moves</u> An intervention Programme created to help children in mainstream school improve their physical development.	<u>Music Therapy</u> 1:1 sessions with a trained music therapist from an external company.	<u>Breakfast Club</u> A small group of children supported on entry to school to regulate and have the option of breakfast.	<u>Interactive Play</u> An individualised programme that supports children's play development and models effective interaction with peers.
