What sounds do you have in your name? Do you have any digraphs?



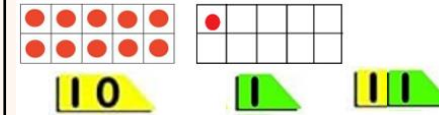
