Seasonal Changes 1: What are the main changes in Autumn?

What should I already know?

- Weather changes at different times of the year.
- When it rains the ground becomes wetter.
- Leaves fall from some trees.
- Know the names of some common types of weather.

Key Knowledge

- There are 4 seasons in one year.
- The seasons are Autumn, Winter, Spring and Summer.
- In Autumn, the length of daylight is shorter and the nights are longer.
- Some trees lose their leaves in Autumn.
- Weather often changes in Autumn.
- We need to wear a jacket or a coat as the weather is usually cold, windy, rainy, cloudy.
- Even though it is usually cold, it can still be **sunny** in **Autumn**.

Key Vocabulary and definitions

Season	One of 4 parts of the year.
Autumn	The season after summer and before winter.
Daylight	Light from the sun.
Night	Darkness each day when there is not light from the sun.
Weather	The conditions outside.
Rain gauge	Equipment that measures how much rain has fallen.
