Key Knowledge and skills gained

- Guy Fawkes was a Catholic who was born in England.
- Guy Fawkes became a soldier who went to **war** and fought on behalf of Spain because it was a **Catholic** country.
- When Guy Fawkes came back from Spain, he was involved in a **plot** to kill King James I.
- During that time, people did not accept each other's beliefs. Guy Fawkes did not like the King because he was Protestant and Guy Fawkes was Catholic.
- The **plot** was called The **Gunpowder Plot**. It happened on the 5th November 1605.
- Guy Fawkes knew how to use gunpowder and that it is very explosive. Guy
 Fawkes and his friends wanted to blow up the Houses of Parliament in London
 with the King inside. They stored 38 barrels of gunpowder in the cellar.
- The plan failed as the King's quards caught Guy Fawkes.
- Guy Fawkes was arrested and put into prison for attempting to kill the King.
- From that day, the King decided that every year on the 5th November we would remember The **Gunpowder Plot** and how Guy Fawkes' plan failed. This is now called Bonfire Night.
- On Bonfire Night people burn bonfires, light fireworks, and sparklers.
