Vocabulary	Definition
Gurdwara	The place of worship in Sikhism
Sikhism	The religion that is followed by Sikhs
Diwali	Also known as the festival of lights. This day is a celebration of right over wrong for Sikhs.
Diva lamp	A small clay pot filled with oil. It is a small candle.
Christianity	The religion that Christians follow.
Christmas	When Christians celebrate the birth of Jesus.
Jesus	The Son of God
Church	A building of worship for Christians.
Advent	The period of time leading up to Christmas.
Islam	The religion followed by Muslims.
Mosque	The place of worship in Islam
Eid	A festival to mark the end of Ramadan.
Ramadan	A time in the year where Muslims fast for a month.
Religious celebrations	A time that people within a religion celebrate.
