- A new metal fence will be installed outside the classroom used for Comets and Shooting Stars.
- At 9am each morning SLT will now close both gates near the Reception playground.
- Staff will check all gates are locked each time they enter the playground.
- New radios will be purchased to ensure that all staff are able to call for additional support as and when required and alert SLT of any incidents quickly.
- Regular reminders will be shared with parents to ensure that the playground is clear by 9am to allow us to secure the site. Please can we ask that parents do not open gates once they are closed.

We are currently working with suppliers and contractors to ensure the gates and fences can be repaired/installed as soon as possible.
