Parents and carers can work through weekly online modules that contain videos, quizzes and interactive worksheets. Parents and carers are also supported by a weekly telephone/video call appointment with a clinician.

You can access OSI at a convenient time for you using any electronic device.

OSI is being delivered by Leicestershire Partnership NHS Mental Health support team in schools. For further information please contact Mr Lang who will be able to make a referral for you to access this service. You can contact Mr Lang via Reception or Class Dojo.
