Dear parents and carers,

We have enjoyed the cooler weather this week and it has been wonderful to see the children engaging in learning and working hard. During my daily walks this week I have had the pleasure of observing a variety of different lessons, behaviour around school is positive and the children are able to answer questions about their learning.

On Monday 11th September Mrs Coplin led our Speak Out. Stay Safe. Assembly. The children listened really well during the assembly and were reminded of the importance of keeping safe and sharing any worries and concerns with trusted adults. We were also fortunate to have another assembly on Wednesday, this was led by our Safer Streets team who talked to the children about idling and the importance of turning car engines off to protect the environment.

Communication

We have worked hard over a number of years to improve our communication with parents, we have listened and responded to feedback and have made several changes to the way we communicate with parents. However, we still feel this is an area that we can improve. Over the next few weeks, we will be rolling out a new communication system called Class Dojo, this is an app that parents can download. This app is already in use at the Junior School and we hope that will allow us to share information with parents quickly and effectively. More information on Class Dojo will be shared next week.
