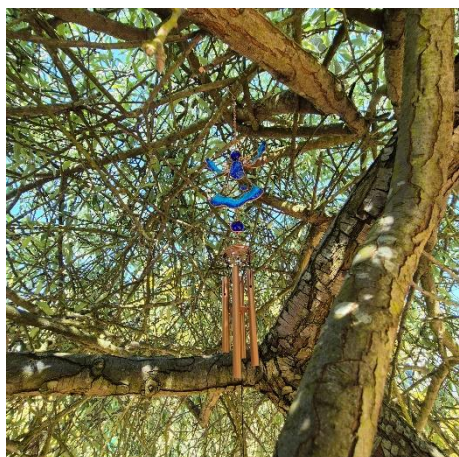


We would also like help from anyone who could come and water over half term - just once would be great!
