Yellow – Marwane and Florence

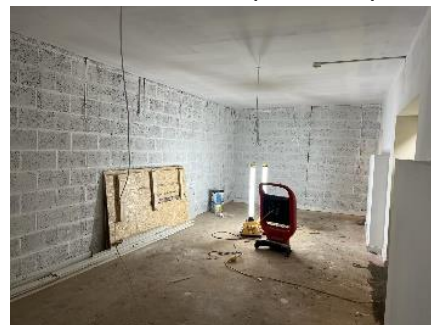
