What should I already know?

• There are places that are different to where we live: jungle, hot and cold deserts.

Key Knowledge

- There are different places to where we live.
- There are people who live in a city, village or by the coast and sea.
- People may go on holiday to a coast and swim in the sea.
- On a coast you would see sand, shells and rocks. This is where the land meets the sea.
- In the sea there are animals such as fish and plants like seaweed.
- An ocean is bigger than the sea. An ocean is further away from the coast and the water is deeper with lots more animals.
- Many people live in a city. We live in Leicester City.
- In a city you will find busy roads, lots of cars and buildings.
- Sometimes you may see litter and pollution in these places which is harmful to people and animals.
