

What should I already know?

- Experience of planting seeds and caring for growing plants.
- Understanding of the key features of the life cycle of a plant.
- Different types of weather and some changes linking to the 4 seasons.

Key Knowledge

- A **plant** is a living thing that usually **grows** in soil.
- Some **plants** have **roots**, a **stem**, **leaves** and **flowers**.
- A **seed** can be planted to **grow** into a new **plant**.
- Some **seeds** can be planted in **Winter** but must be kept warm to **grow**.
- The **stem** will **grow** in length.
- A **plant** will **grow** new **leaves**.
- The **roots** will become longer.
- In **Spring**, the weather is usually warmer and **plants** can **grow** outside.
- In **Summer**, the weather is warmer so **seeds** and **plants** can **grow** outside.

Key Vocabulary and Definitions

Plant	A living thing that usually grows in soil.
Seed	A part of a plant that can grow into a new plant.
Growth	When a living thing gets bigger.
Measure	What you do to find the size or amount of something.
Trowel	Equipment that is used for lifting plants or soil.
Observe	To watch.
Seasons	Autumn, Winter, Spring, Summer.
