


## Reception: Understanding the World: Science





## What should I already know?

- In Autumn, the weather starts to get colder. We need to wear clothes that keep us warm.
- In Winter, the weather is cold. It can be wet, snowy and icy outside.
- In Spring, plants and flowers start to grow.

## Key Knowledge


- There are 4 seasons in one year: autumn, winter, spring, summer.
- The weather changes in each season.
- In spring, the weather starts to get warmer and plants start to grow.
- In spring the weather can be sunny but can also be rainy, windy, cloudy.
- In summer, the weather is usually hot.
- In autumn and winter, the paths outside my have been wet and muddy but in the spring and summer they may be dry because the weather is warmer.
- When the weather gets warmer, we can wear clothes like shorts and t-shirts to keep us cool.
- Outside we will notice bee's and butterflies around.









