Key Vocabulary and Definitions	
	Definition
Bookmark	A bookmark is a thin marking tool, commonly made of card, leather, or fabric, used to keep track of a reader's progress in a book and allow the reader to easily return to where the previous reading session ended.
Design	To plan and think about what you would like your final product to look like.
Thread	A long thin strand of fibre used in sewing or weaving.
Weave	Weaving is the craft of lacing fibres together to make fabric or cloth
Sew	To join two pieces of cloth together by putting thread through them with a needle:
Embroider	To decorate a cloth by sewing patterns on it with thread.
Wool	The fine, soft curly hair of a sheep or goat which can be made into a cloth or yarn.
Hessian	A type of thick, rough cloth used for things and coverings that must be strong
