| Beat | A rhythmic unit in music. |

| Compose | To create a piece of music. |
| Note | A single tone in music. |
| Tune | Musical notes joined together to make a melody. |
| Sound Effect | A sound other than speech or music. |
| Soundtrack | A recording of the musical accompaniment of a film or TV programme. |
| Speed | The number of beats per minutes (bpm) played in the music. |
| Tempo | The speed at which the music plays. |
| Volume | How loud or quiet the music is. |

Key Questions

What is meant by digital music?

Digital music is made using a computer or other device. Digital music allows the computer to copy the sound made by instruments and combine them together to make a piece of music.

How can I change how my music sounds?

You can change how your digital music sounds in many ways. One way is to increase the tempo of the music or vary the volume of each instrument in the piece.

What is it meant by the tempo of the music?

Tempo is measured in BPM, or beats per minute. One beat every second is 60 BPM.
