Key Knowledge

- There are **four** seasons in one year.
- The season names are **spring, summer, autumn** and **winter**.
- **Spring** is the season **after winter** and **before summer**.
- In **spring**, **plants** start to grow from the ground.
- In **spring**, some **trees** regrow their leaves. Some trees grow blossom during spring.
- In **spring**, there are **more** hours of **daylight**.
- The **nights** start to become **shorter**.
- The **weather** often changes quickly in **spring**.
- Animals are no longer hibernating and some give birth to babies.
