Key Knowledge

- There are **four** seasons in one year.
- The season names are spring, summer, autumn and winter.
- **Spring** is the season **after winter** and **before summer**.
- In **spring**, **plants** start to grow from the ground.
- In spring, some trees regrow their leaves. Some trees grow blossom during spring.
- In **spring**, there are **more** hours of **daylight**.
- The **nights** start to become **shorter**.
- The weather often changes quickly in spring.
- Animals are no longer hibernating and some give birth to babies.
